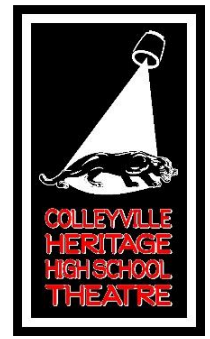

CHHS THEATRE BOOSTER CLUB VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

BANQUET CHAIR

The Banquet Chairperson is responsible for designing and producing the end of year banquet in May. Responsible for planning all aspects of banquet function held at the Colleyville Community Center in 2019, including but not limited, menus, ticket pricing, favors, decorations and other expenses of the banquet held in conjunction with Annual Awards presentations.

CONCESSIONS COORDINATOR

The Concession Coordinator is responsible for procuring inventory, scheduling and managing the concession sales for CHHS Theatre performances.

FRONT-OF-HOUSE COORDINATOR

The Front-of-House Coordinator oversees the Volunteer House Manager program. Volunteer House Managers ensure that all ticketing, concession, ticket taking/ushering functions are running smoothly for each performance.

FUNDRAISING CHAIRPERSON

The Fundraising Chairperson is responsible for coordinating and planning initiatives that raise money for CHHS Booster Club throughout the year. The Fundraising Chair will recruit and develop volunteers as they deem necessary to help with the planning, setup and execution of each program.

HISTORIAN

The historian keeps a record on the Theatre department's activities for the year. The position might create a "digital scrapbook" to promote the theatre department, and its activities and achievements. Another great job for the historian is to help officers and committee chairs assemble a record of important information that will help successors, i.e. key contacts, dos and don'ts, cost information, etc.

PLAYBILL COORDINATOR

The Playbill coordinator is responsible for designing and producing the Playbill for each performance.

PUBLICITY COORDINATOR

The Publicity Coordinator is responsible for promoting a positive image of the booster club and theatre program to campus and the local community by creating materials and cultivating media relations. Works with the Publicity Committee to develop and distribute press releases, create social media campaigns, and promote booster club membership.

SCHOLARSHIP COORDINATOR

The Scholarship Coordinator is responsible for the planning, coordination and communication of the CHHS Theatre Scholarship program.

STARVING ARTIST COORDINATOR

The Starving Artist Program Coordinator is responsible for coordinating the planning, procuring and delivery of meals for the actors, technical artists and staff for each show.

STATE FESTIVAL COORDINATOR

The State Festival Coordinator works closely with Theatre Arts directors in the planning and logistics coordination for students and production at the annual Texas State Thespians Festival.

TICKETING COORDINATOR

The Ticketing Coordinator oversees all aspects of ticketing operations and manages ticket office volunteers for each performance.

T-SHIRT COORDINATOR

The T-shirt Coordinator is responsible for coordinating the design and production of the performance apparel and booster apparel.

WEBMASTER

The Webmaster is responsible for the design and maintenance of the booster club content posted on the booster club web page.
